Eddie Lee Jones was born September 11, 1932 to Johnnie K. and Salley Jones in Stanton, Tennessee. He was one of three children.

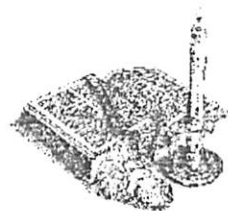
At an early age, he accepted Christ as his Lord and Savior.
