And freedom from all harm.



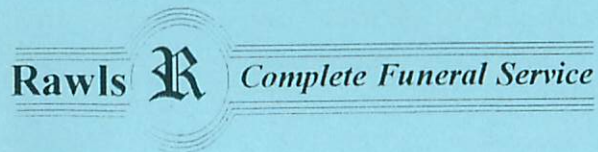

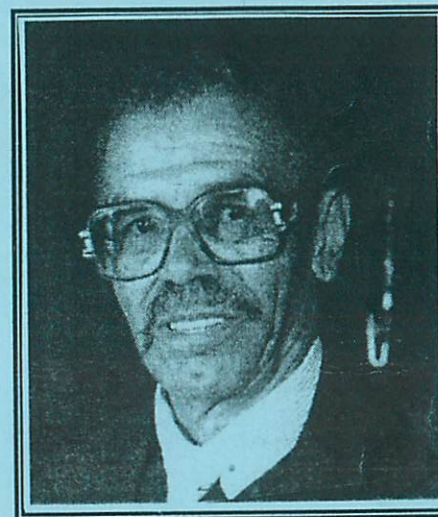
